#### **INSTRUCTIONS TO COMPETITORS AND COACHES**

1. Registration from 9:45 a.m. to 10:45 a.m. in Lakewood Civic Centre , 1635 McKercher Drive. **Coaches must register schools and pick up numbers at this time. Registration ends at 10:45 a.m.** Entry fees not sent with the entry forms must be paid before numbers for the entire team are issued. **Coaches must pick up numbers for the entire school at one time.**
2. Because this meet is sanctioned but the SSSAD, no Saskatchewan Athletics Day Pass is required. Athletes are to **compete with their schools**, so everyone involved is insured.
3. All those wishing to go over the course should report to the start line for course tours at 10:30 a.m.
4. Washrooms are available in the Lakewood Civic Centre.
5. Awards will be handed out at the tents near the finish line as soon as results are available.
6. Medals will be presented to the top three of each division. Ribbons will be presented to the top ten finishers and a trophy to the top team in each division.
7. Teams will consist of a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 5 athletes. Schools may enter as many teams as they wish in each category. The best three finishers of each team will be scored.
